

4-PIECE BRONCHUS



Hypersecretion

Airway constriction due to excessive mucus production. In addition to asthma, this condition is characteristic of chronic bronchitis.



Asthma is a condition of reversible bronchial narrowing by mucosal edema (swelling), hypersecretion of mucus and/or muscle spasm. All three conditions limit the airflow and can cause wheezing, breathlessness, chest tightness, and cough.
